CERF EYE CLINIC

Dr. J. F. Swanson, Board Certified Ophthalmologist will examine for hereditary eye defects and complete forms for CERF certification.

HEART MURMUR SCREENING FOR OFA and/or ARCH Registry CERTIFICATION:

Dr. Kyle Brayley, Board Certified Cardiologist, will conduct a cardiac exam to detect heart murmurs and will complete OFA forms and/or ARCH Registry for certification.

The ACVIM Registry of Cardiac Health, also known as ARCH, is restricted to examinations by Board Certified Cardiologists and the information is maintained electronically.

Dr. Brayley will continue to sign the OFA forms; OFA Cardiac Application forms can be downloaded at www.offa.org. However, Dr. Brayley is requesting that we also enter our information on the ARCH system so they can start developing the information for research purposes. The website for ARCH is www.archcertify.com. **Please be sure to enter your dog's information into the ARCH system and bring a copy of the completed form to the Clinic.** If you need assistance, please call Mickie at 832-222-2965.

The OFA registration fee for dogs done at this clinic will be \$7.50 instead of the regular \$15.00.

Patellar CLINIC

Dr Max Banwell, DVM, MS, Diplomate American College of Veterinary Surgeons, Board Certified Orthopedic Specialists, will examine for Patella Luxation and complete the form for OFA certification as well as provide orthopedic evaluation, which is especially beneficial for senior dogs. The Patellar Luxation Application can be found at www.offa.org. Please bring completed applications to the clinic.
